## **NOTIFICATION OF THE AVAILABILITY**OF UNEMPLOYMENT INSURANCE BENEFITS

April 16, 2020

Unemployment insurance (UI) benefits are available to workers who are unemployed and who meet the requirements of South Carolina's UI eligibility laws. You may file a UI claim if you are separated from employment or if your work hours are reduced.

You will need to provide DEW with the following information in order to process your claim:

- Your full legal name;
- Your Social Security Number; and
- Your authorization to work (if you are not a US citizen or resident).
